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Notes

The text is written in “hyphae”: long lines that echo one another and are phonically related, in that consonantal sounds are restricted to those in the word “mycelium,” i.e. ⟨m⟩, ⟨s⟩ and ⟨l⟩. The letter “s” is not voiced (⟨z⟩, as in “rose”). Other consonantal sounds appear only in the “mushrooms” that occasionally erupt.

Der Text ist in „Hyphen“ geschrieben: lange Zeilen, die sich gegenseitig wiederholen und phonetisch verwandt sind, da die Konsonanten auf die im Wort „Myzel“ vorkommenden Laute beschränkt sind, d. h. „m“, „s“ und „l“. Der Buchstabe „s“ ist nicht stimmhaft („z“, wie in „rose“). Andere konsonantische Laute kommen nur in den „Pilzen“ vor, die gelegentlich ausbrechen.
